Julia –

I am requesting that the current pause be extended to July 31, 2026. I was contacted by Sarah Emher of County Water Resources on June 24, 2026 requesting a meeting to discuss water usage at the facility, specifically:

“We also are interested in discussing the proposed use of water for the new buildings proposed under CUP2025-00047. We have requested and are interested in estimated water usage for what currently is being covered under the stockwater exemption for the purpose of watering stock and bottle feeding calves only (not including secondary uses), and a quantification of all other water uses including secondary uses associated with keeping stock (dust abatement, cleaning and sanitation of animals, facilities and equipment and irrigation) and domestic use and industrial commercial uses under current conditions. These calculations should be provided as withdrawals from each water source (well) listed in CUP2025-00047.”

Due to schedule conflicts for both the County and the Veldhuis', the meeting date was set for this coming Monday, July 20th. The discussions during this meeting will be critical to addressing County questions concerning water usage at the facility.
