Dear Yakima County Commissioners:

As I stated on May 6, the Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency is currently barely functioning. Given Yakima County's responsibilities under the law¹, I ask again for the opportunity to describe YRCAA problems to the Board of County Commissioners.

To highlight the importance of this request, consider these issues:

- There have only been four YRCAA board members since the end of March. The law requires five board members. The YRCAA was supposed to begin filling this position in the fall of 2024, when the YRCAA first became aware of a pending vacancy. ²
- There has been no clerk of the board as required by YRCAA Administrative Code Part A, for over two months. The YRCAA Executive Director has performed clerical duties in the interim. The YRCAA is paying this man \$130,000 per year to answer phones
- The YRCAA has failed to report staff activities since January. Neither the YRCAA
 board nor the public have any way of knowing how many air complaints have been
 filed, how many notices of violation issued, how many inspections performed, how
 many permits issued, etc. Numbers for FY 2025 are far below those for FY 2024.
- There has been no reporting of air quality for Yakima County since January.
- Voucher and payroll authorizations were missing from the regular business portion of YRCAA board meetings for January and May. In February of 2025 the board approved vouchers and payrolls for October, November, and December of 2024.



We expect no PM_{2.5} exceedances for the month of December.





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
